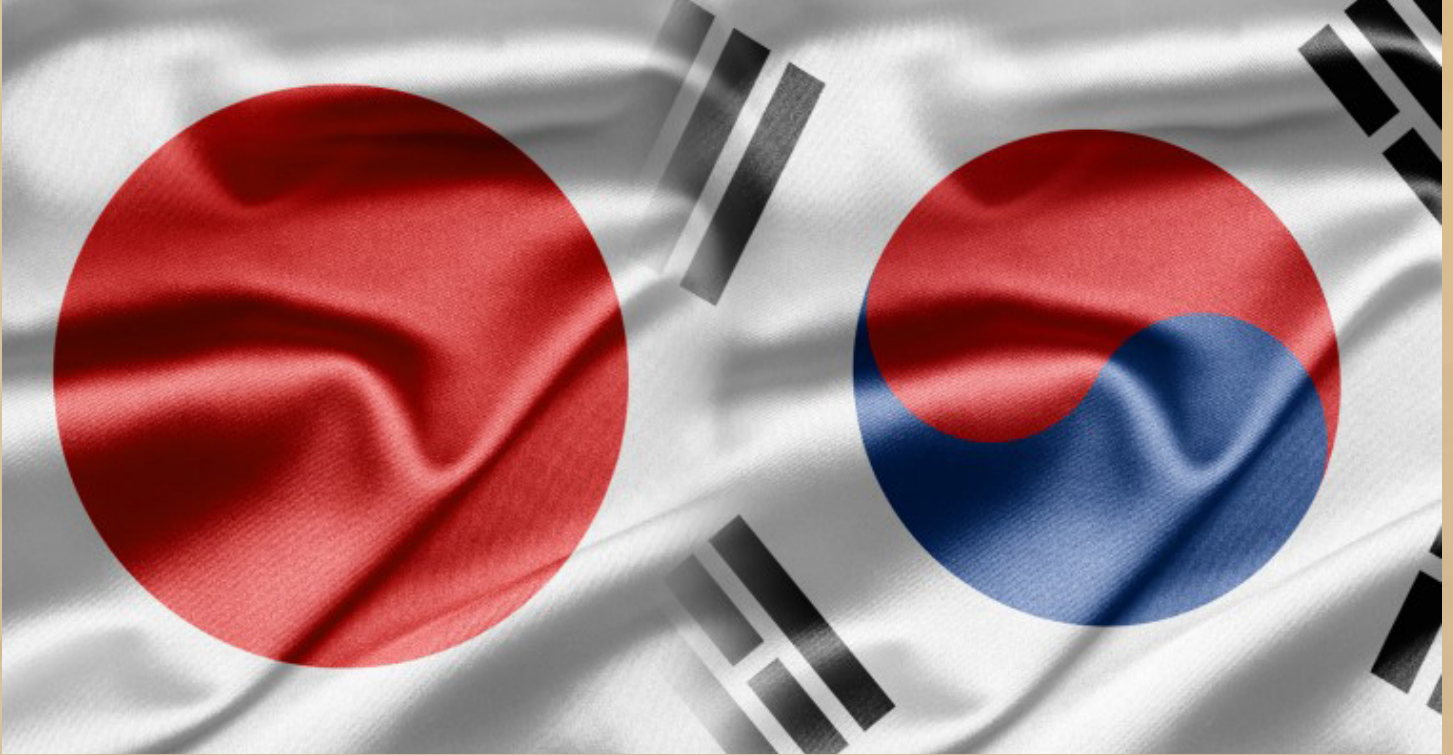


# Liu Distinguished Visitor Series

Gavan McCormack is a University of London Ph.D (1974), emeritus professor of Australian National University and a Fellow of the Australian Academy of the Humanities. He is author of many books on modern and contemporary East Asia, widely published in Japanese, Korean, and Chinese as well as English. His two most recent books, both published in 2018, are *The State of the Japanese State: Contested Identity, Direction, and Role* (Folkestone, Kent: Renaissance Books) and (co-authored with Satoko Oka Norimatsu) *Resistant Islands: Okinawa Confronts Japan and the United States* (Lanham, Maryland: Rowman and Littlefield).
